The library has a new Great Lakes Marine Collection thanks to a generous donation by Jerry Walter. Jerry wrote the “Ships Log” column of the Grand Haven Tribune for thirteen years and used these books, directories, periodicals, maps, and brochures as resources for the column.

The collection has materials covering all aspects of maritime activities in the Great Lakes region. It includes individual ship histories and profiles as well as profiles and directories of the people working on the lakes. The entire “Namesakes of the Lakes” series by John Greenwood, the “Greenwood and Dill’s Lake Boats”, “Great Lakes Red Books”, every issue of the journal “Inland Seas” from 1945 to the present, and directories of the Lake Carriers’ Association are among the titles available.

Many of the items in this collection are unusual and rare, including some titles available only at Spring Lake District Library and the Library of Congress. This collection is an exciting and valuable addition to our community and regional resources.
